

Le lion était le roi de la jungle.


Tout le monde tremblait de peur et d'effroi lorsqu'il rugissait.

Au bout de deux jours, la douleur était devenue insupportable.


— Puis-je jeter un œil ? demanda une souris un soir, tandis que le lion était seul.
