


Mais ils sont aussi gros et lourds.

Et cela ne leur facilite pas les choses lorsqu'ils chassent




Sur vingt tentatives, le tigre ne parvient en général à n'attraper qu'une seule proie.


Le cerf aboyeur crie comme un chien apeuré.
